## Instructions for the scientific report of the Swedish Brain Foundation's research grant

The scientific report should be uploaded after the end of the grant period or three months after Hjärnfonden has granted an extension of the grant (see contract/approval of conditions). If researchers hold a research grant which stretches over two or three years, the reports can be uploaded at the end of the last grant year.

The scientific report should be uploaded in 3D-data as a PDF file. Select "Upload New Document" in the system after selecting the current project.

Please note that the Swedish Brain Foundation wants interpretations and analysis of the results achieved, not only a publication list.

The report should contain the following headings:

## The purpose of the project

A short summary of the project, as well as possible changes during the project period.

## **Achieved results**

This section should contain a descriptive and comprehensive analysis of the results achieved. In addition, describe what the grant has meant in practice in obtaining new knowledge about the normal functioning of the nervous system as well as diseases, injuries and disabilities related to the brain, spinal cord and other parts of the nervous system. Please indicate how the results could improve future treatments of diseases, injuries and disabilities.

Do not attach offprints or manuscripts!

Also list the following items:

- 1. Peer-reviewed articles published or accepted for publication
- 2. Review articles, book chapters and books
- 3. Doctoral students active in the project/or equivalent. Specify the dissertation year or the planned year for the dissertation
- 4. Manuscripts
- 5. Patents

Other type of outreach activities/communication of project results such as conferences, seminars, lectures etc.
